- ☐ Award will not be granted posthumously
- ☐ Nominees must be an active member of a NSWCRU Affiliated Body, Zone or Club
- ☐ Groups or Couples will only be considered in very special circumstances
- ☐ A person cannot receive the Volunteer of the Year Award twice
- ☐ Unsuccessful nominees may be nominated in subsequent years
- ☐ Nominees must be in good standing within the Rugby Community and not have a criminal record
- ☐ Paid employees are ineligible for nomination
- ☐ Nominee and Nominator must NOT be the same person
- ☐ Nominees must agree to any information, images or photographs submitted with the nomination may be used for promotion and publicity purposes

Judging Criteria

- ☐ Significant contribution to the sport of Rugby
- ☐ Innovation and leadership
- ☐ Demonstration of Community Rugby participation
- ☐ Meeting an identified Community Rugby need
- ☐ Meeting an identified Affiliated Body, Zone or Club need
- ☐ Contribution of best practice principles
