Rugby & Two Year Window Forms Senior

There continues to be confusion over the Senior Rugby & Two Year Window Protocols.

Senior Rugby Form

Must be completed by players U18 who want to play Senior Rugby.

Note: NSWCRU will not endorse any players U17 being cleared to play Senior Rugby.

Note: CNRU does not endorse any player U17 being cleared to play Senior Rugby

The form must be completed in full, together with it being signed by:

- Players Parent/Guardian
- Accredited Level 2 Coach (Current Accreditation& SmartRugby Compliant)
- Competition Manager

Any players who play in the front row must also complete a Front Row Exception – Submission Form.

This form has to be submitted to the ARU, and the player can't play in the front row until cleared by the ARU.

Two Year Window Form

Must be completed by players who want to play above their age i.e. U16 – U18, U17 – U19

Note: Players cleared to play in U19 competitions are not clear to play in Senior competitions.

The form must be completed in full, together with it being signed by:

- Players Parent/Guardian
- Accredited Level 2 Coach (Current Accreditation& SmartRugby Compliant)
- Competition Manager

The Competition Manager has the final say on players being cleared under both protocols.

Note: CNRU will not automatically clear players – the 2 year window requires approval from both the CNRU Zone President and the Competition Manager
