

## CNRU Zone Registrar Report 2015 Season

### Achievements

- Rugbylink set up and running on schedule in time for season commencement.
- Online player registration and transfers established.
- Continuation of Two Tier competition.
- Improved layout of match sheets following suggestions from club scorers.
- Referee best and fairest enforced – full season B&F table published.
- Texting of scores and match sheet jpegs continue to be preferred communication of match results.
- Sin bin and send off reports updated to reflect Rugbylink reporting requirements.
- All forms and competition procedures updated on website
- Media reports consistently sent out by 6.00 pm on Saturday evening
- No paper based player registration forms required to be lodged.
- Clarification of semi-final eligibility with assistance of David Cummings
- Email Correspondence – 2,800+ competition related emails received. 1,300 + competition related emails sent.

### Looking Ahead

- By Laws to be updated
- Clarification of semi-final eligibility rules – to take into account anomalies arising from 2 tier completion if it goes ahead again.
- Recommend that second grade compete in 2 tiers as per first grade.
- Deadlines for match results and game entry to be enforced – fines introduced?
- Edited finals videos required for website.
- Add penalty try line to match results sheet.
- Match sheets to be checked before being submitted to ensure referee to sign, opposition manager/official to sign, sin bins and yellows to be checked against refs match record, only starting line-up to be entered on the match sheet before players take the field (except in finals) to ensure that players who do not take the field are not entered on the sheet.
- Player numbers to be entered in Rugbylink as per match sheet to ensure sin bins and B&F are recorded correctly.
- Suggest that referee B&F be announced during post-match speeches to ensure that players are acknowledged and referees don't have to be followed up for missing B&F.

- I have requested Rugbylink be enhanced by the ARU to allow clubs to run their own sin bin reports and for the on line match sanctioning system to be turned on.

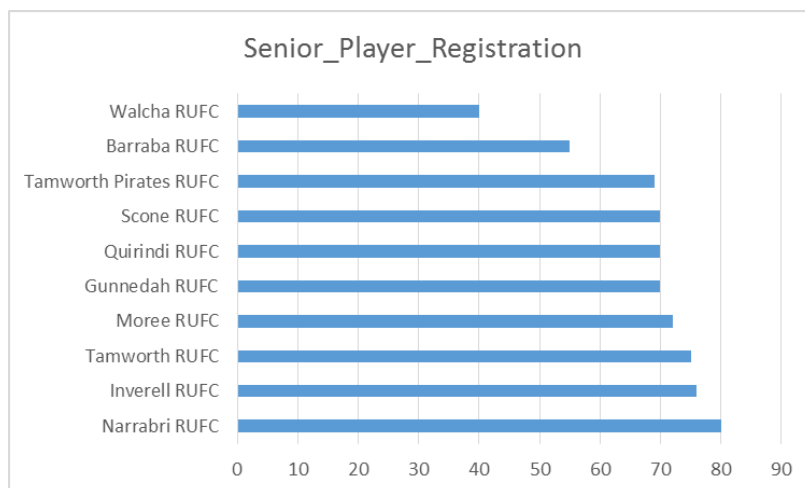
I would also like to thank David Cumming for his continued support and clarification and interpretation of the by laws, particularly due to anomalies arising with the two tier competition and the shortened season.
